1. Reference (a) forwarded an application for the renewal of Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. STB-930. Reference (b) requested additional information be provided prior to reissuing this NRC License.
2. NRC license STB-930 was issued to cover operations associated with the handling of waste materials resulting from minor repairs or corrosion removal from POLARIS missile equipment sections and interstage sections. These missile sections are made from a magnesium alloy containing 3% Thorium. The operations for which the license was originally issued have been discontinued and there is no material requiring disposal.
3. While we are retaining several of these missile sections in storage, reference (c) allows an exception to licensing requirements when dealing with finished products containing less than 4% Thorium.
4. It is requested that license STB-930 be cancelled.
