

MATERIALS LICENSE

Pursuant to the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, the Energy Reorganization Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-438), and Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter I, Parts 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 40 and 70, and in reliance on statements and representations heretofore made by the licensee, a license is hereby issued authorizing the licensee to receive, acquire, possess, and transfer byproduct, source, and special nuclear material designated below; to use such material for the purpose(s) and at the place(s) designated below; to deliver or transfer such material to persons authorized to receive it in accordance with the regulations of the applicable Part(s). This license shall be deemed to contain the conditions specified in Section 183 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and is subject to all applicable rules, regulations and orders of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission now or hereafter in effect and to any conditions specified below.

CONDITIONS

10. Licensed material may be stored at Department of Defense facilities and may be stored or used on U.S. Navy ships anywhere in the United States and anywhere the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission maintains jurisdiction for regulating the use of licensed material.
11. The licensee shall comply with the provisions of Title 10, Chapter 1, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 19, "Notices, Instructions and Reports to Workers; Inspections" and Part 20, "Standards for Protection Against Radiation."
12. Licensed material shall be used by, or under the supervision of, anyone designated by the U. S. Navy.

CONDITIONS

13. Pursuant to 10 CFR 20.501, the licensee is exempt from posting Naval warship magazines containing depleted uranium munitions with radioactive material caution signs as specified in 10 CFR 20.203(e)(2), provided such areas are posted with signs bearing the statements described in letter dated January 25, 1985.
14. The licensee may transport licensed material or deliver licensed material to a carrier for transport in accordance with the provisions of Title 10, Code of Regulations, Part 71, "Packaging of Radioactive Material for Transport and Transportation of Radioactive Material Under Certain Conditions."
15. Except as specifically provided otherwise by this license, the licensee shall possess and use licensed material described in Items 6, 7, and 8 of this license in accordance with statements, representations, and procedures contained in application dated February 14, 1979; and letters dated September 10, 1980, February 24, 1981, February 25, 1982, March 5, 1984, January 25, 1985, and June 28, 1985. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulation shall govern the licensee's statements in applications or letters, unless the statements are more restrictive than the regulations.
