Dear Mr. Patterson,

As discussed in the May 15, 1985 phone conversation with Ms. Elker of my office, request Conditions 10, 12, and 14D of the US Army Armament, Munitions, and Chemical Command Byproduct Material license 12-00722-14 be amended to state the following or equivalent:

Condition 10. "Licensed material may be used at military installations anywhere in the United States."

Condition 12. "Licensed material shall be used by, or under the supervision of, Elizabeth A. Peterson, David P. Skogman, Byron Morris or DoD military or civilian personnel trained in accordance with the application dated Nov 24, 1984, and letters dated Feb 5, 1985 and Mar 21, 1985.

Condition 14D. "Tests for leakage and/or contamination shall be performed by the licensee or in accordance with the application dated Nov 24, 1984, and letters dated Feb 5, 1985 and Mar 21, 1985, or persons specifically authorized by the Commission or an Agreement State to perform such services.

Amendment to the Conditions will eliminate several field questions regarding interpretation of temporary job sites, authorized users, and authorized individuals for leak test performance, respectively. Your cooperation and assistance in this matter is appreciated.
