I am responding to your letter of August 1, 1985 pursuant to the routine safety inspection conducted by Judith A. Joustra at our New Jersey facility on June 26, 1985. I apologize for the delay in responding to your letter. I had difficulty in obtaining NRC form 314 and received it from your office on September 4, 1985.

I have completed NRC 314 requesting a termination of our NRC license for the Pleasantville, NJ facility (license no. 29-17962-01).

Response to Appendix A Notice of Violation

As corrective actions: 1) I have completed NRC form 314. 2) I have attached to that form a diagram of the laboratory area that was previously used for radioactive materials. The radiation survey material shown on that report shows that the levels of radiation are at background levels. Corrective steps to avoid further violations in this area will include a modification of our procedures to allow for notification of the NRC if any other laboratory areas are to be released for unrestricted use. I hope that you will consider us to be in full compliance when you have received and reviewed this response. At that time I request that you terminate our license for the Pleasantville, NJ facility.
