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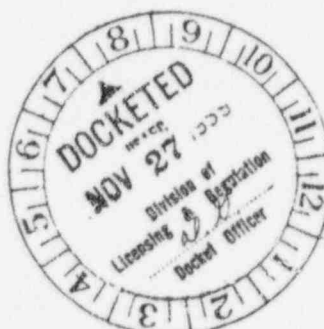

Reference is made to your memoranda of November 10, September 14, and March 27 concerning a complaint by Nuclear Engineering Company against Isotope Specialties Company regarding transportation of radioactive wastes and disposal of low-level liquid wastes into the sanitary sewer system by Isotope Specialties.

Isotope Specialties Company was notified on March 18, 1959, that the transportation condition covering intrastate transportation of radioactive material would be made a part of their license. This license was issued before the Commission had developed the transportation condition which is now used on all waste disposal licenses. Before the condition was added, however, Isotope Specialties Company's status changed from that of a subsidiary of Nuclear Corporation of America to a Division of Nuclear Corporation of America. This required a transfer of the existing Isotope Specialties license in accordance with Section 30.28 of 10 CFR 30. Since personnel and procedural changes were involved in the change in status of Isotope Specialties, it is necessary that a new license be issued. Further information in regard to issuing this new license is being obtained. The new license, when issued, will contain the same transportation condition which appears on the license of Nuclear Engineering Company as well as other waste disposal licensees.

In regard to disposal of radioactive waste via the sewer, each licensee including waste disposal licensees is authorized to carry out such disposal in accordance with the limitations of Section 20.303 of Part 20.
