Gentlemen:

This refers to your letter dated July 10, 1985, for an amendment to Materials License 45-04169-03.

Enclosed is a copy of Part 170 of the Commission's regulations which specifies fees for facilities and materials licenses. Please note that §170.11(a)(4) of Part 170 exempts from fees licenses applied for by, or issued to nonprofit educational institutions when the byproduct, source, or special nuclear material is used for teaching, training, or medical purposes, except human use. This exemption only applies when the nuclear material is being used in a teaching or training program for students.

Based on the information contained in your letter, we could not determine if the research activities qualify for the exemption in Part 170. Please advise us whether the material is to be used for teaching or training purposes. If the use of radioactive material for research includes activities other than teaching or training of students, an application fee of \$700 is required as specified in §170.31 (3M) of 10 CFR 170. Payment should be made to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and mailed to my attention at our Washington, D.C. address.

Your application will be sent to the Licensing staff for processing upon receipt of verification that the materials will be used for teaching or training of students or upon receipt of the \$700 application fee. Please refer to CONTROL NUMBER 250653 when replying.
