SUBJECT: ADDITIONAL INFORMATION CONCERNING A MATERIAL LICENSE  
APPLICATION (REFERENCE MAIL CONTROL NUMBER 50664)

The following is a response to your request for additional details to our application dated July 10, 1985. Please let me state at the outset that our management decisions have been clarified to the point that the Sterling, Virginia, facility at this time is not scheduled to be a location for the Lixiscope or for the I-125 source. Future needs for real-time X-ray evaluation of produced goods are being discussed for the Sterling plant. Should requirements be found for a Lixiscope in Sterling, the unit and source material shall be requisitioned and ammendment(s) submitted IAW regulations.

I am in the process of being transferred to the Sterling plant. Consequently, my position as RSO must be relinquished. Randall Fenwick, resume attached to the July 10 application and other pertinent information attached to same, will be authorized RSO for the Reston facilities.

Please note the following information supplied per your request:

1. Sterling, Virginia, Facility. The attached facility sketch is of the Reston, Virginia, Facilities.
2. Authorized Users. The names of individual users on our current license are to be deleted from the program, with the exception of Stewart Swift, whose resume you have. Mr. Swift is an individual user working under direct supervision. Mssrs. Fenwick, Scholbe, and King and Ms. Bainbridge are authorized users and direct supervisors and are the names to be used on the license, Condition 12. Mssrs. Smith, Pennington, Tran and (again) Swift are to be supervised while using the Lixiscope after having been


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trained per NRC Form 313 I, Item 15, 4.

3. Training of Individual Users. It is not our intent that each employee to be named as an individual user on our license will complete the Glenbrook Training Program. Training will be based NRC Form 313 I, Item 15, 4. (See number 2 above.)
4. As discussed above, our Lixiscope will not be transported to or from the Sterling facilities, at this time.
