Gentlemen:

Enclosed is Amendment 03 to License No. 24-19360-0170. Note that we are not able to add the name of Michael Clements as an authorized user at this time.

It appears that the hours that Mr. Clements obtained at Belleville Area College were oriented primarily toward the field of X-ray technology. We are not able to verify that Mr. Clements obtained 200 hours of training specifically applicable to the handling and use of radioisotopes in unsealed form, either at Belleville Area College or elsewhere. Our criteria for determining what constitutes "acceptable training" was set forth in a letter of February 11, 1981 (copy enclosed).

I am also enclosing a copy of the text of a presentation that I gave at this year's APHA meeting and a copy of Appendix A to Regulatory Guide 10.0. These documents will provide additional information concerning NRC training and experience criteria for authorized users on nuclear pharmacy licenses.
