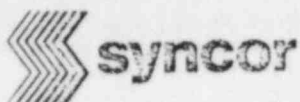

Syncor International Corporation has reviewed the terms and conditions of the following NRC licenses, and will assure that these operations continue to abide by the terms and conditions of their licenses:




