Mr. Baur visited our office to discuss the status of their application for a sea disposal license. Mr. Baur was informed that we cannot transfer License No. 4-580-6 to their new corporate entity as this license covers source material and such licenses are non-transferable pursuant to Section 40.27 of 10 CFR 40. Mr. Baur was informed that the proposed alternative which we would suggest would be to publish in the Federal Register a notice of issuance of a new license which would cover their waste disposal program as presently licensed under License No. 4-580-6. It was pointed out to Mr. Baur that it will be necessary to publish a notice of issuance of the new license in the Federal Register and the license would become effective as of the date signed. However, the notice would contain an opportunity for intervention within thirty (30) days after the date of issuance of their new license. Mr. Baur felt that this would be agreeable to Isotopes Specialties Company and he will contact Mr. Michaud concerning this matter to see if it was also agreeable with him.

Mr. Baur called back later on in the day and stated that Mr. Michaud agrees to the issuance of a new license.



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
