Mr. Michaud and Mr. Baur were in the AEC building for other purposes and stopped by to inquire regarding the status of their waste disposal license application for transfer of corporate entity from Isotopes Specialties Co., Inc., to Isotopes Specialties Co., Division of Nuclear Corporation of America, Inc. They were advised that the proposed amendment had been forwarded to OGC for review and that it would have to proceed from there to Mr. Kirk and Mr. Price. No time of issuance was indicated. They were advised that we were not considering the inclusion of the 20 grams of special nuclear material, or any other changes which would constitute an increase in the scope of their license.

Mr. Michaud referenced Item IV of Administrative Procedures For The Disposal of Radioactive Waste, submitted with letter dated September 10, 1959. This section proposes packaging and processing for disposal to AEC licensed land burial sites if and when available. Mr. Michaud wanted to know if it was covered by the present action, since they were particularly interested in it, in view of the recent action authorizing use of land burial facilities at Oak Ridge and Idaho Falls, and the prospects of setting up regional burial sites on state or federal lands. He was advised that this was not covered by the proposed amendment, since we had chosen not to increase the scope of his license in any way. He was told that since this setting up of regional burial sites was a very recent proposal that additional information on it would likely be available in the near future. I called to his attention that there was to be published February 4, 1960 an amendment to Section 20.304 prohibiting burial of waste as a commercial activity on other than state or federally owned land.
