

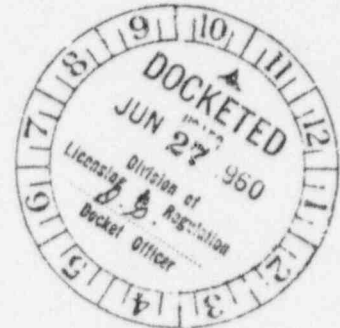

Gentlemen:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 1 to License No. 4-580-6, incorporating the various changes requested in the referenced applications and as noted below.

We have amended license Conditions 4 and 5, and have added several new conditions to incorporate modifications in your procedures governing the transportation, packaging and handling of licensed material. We have also added Condition 11 designating a specific disposal site.

It has been determined that authorization of the large buoy waste container as a sea disposal unit is a substantial change in the considerations contained in the original Notice of Proposed Issuance published in the Federal Register on March 8, 1958, and therefore a notice of proposed issuance of an appropriate amendment incorporating the buoy will be prepared. If intervention is not requested within fifteen (15) days after publication of the notice, the amendment will be issued. You will be advised of further action in this regard.

Gentlemen:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 1 to License No. 4-189-6 issued in accordance with letters dated May 14, June 21 and September 10, 1959.

You will notice that we have amended Condition 3 to list John Vaden as the individual under whose direct supervision the waste disposal program will be conducted. We have amended Conditions 4 and 5, and have added several new conditions to incorporate modifications in your procedures governing the transportation, packaging and handling of licensed material, and have added Condition 11 to designate a specific disposal site. However, we have not authorized possession of special nuclear material or broadened the scope of the license in any way pending action by the Commission on another application discussed below.

The Industrial Waste Disposal Corporation of Houston, Texas, applied for a license to dispose of waste radioactive material in the Gulf of Mexico. After a public hearing on this application, the Hearing Examiner delivered an intermediate decision recommending issuance of the license. However, several intervenors appealed the Hearing Examiner's intermediate decision to the Commissioners and the matter was heard by the Commission on January 20, 1960 and is now under advisement.

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The Commission's decision in this matter may affect existing policy with respect to the issuance of new disposal licenses. Therefore, we have decided not to take final action with respect to any application for initial licensing or to issue amendments to existing licenses which would authorize an increase in their scope, until the Commission's decision in the Industrial Waste Disposal case is delivered.
