

Dear Dr. Glen:

In response to your letter dated June 25, 1985 and subsequent telephone conversations with Mr. Thomas Thompson, we wish to confirm that our Radiation Safety Officer, and a technician assigned to assist, will dedicate whatever effort is required to establish and maintain the licensing requirements at the Jackson Laboratory. During the first 6-9 months we estimated an 80% effort as stated in our letter of 14 June 1985. After this period of installation, Mr. Thompson advises that at least a 50% time dedication will be required based upon his experience with similar license applications. Our Safety Office, headed by our R.S.O., Fred Driscoll, has the primary responsibility of meeting these requirements and objectives.
