Document Control Desk,

I am responding to a "Notice of violation" according to 10 CFR 2.201.

1. I, Michael Muszynski, claim that on November 29, 1995, I did not violate any NRC Regulations which includes 10 CFR 30.9 or 10 CFR 35.50. I firmly resolve that the "Dose Calibrator Constancy Check" in question, was performed accurately by myself on that date.
I cannot explain why my readings were 5% lower than expected other than the "Dose Calibrator" may have been calibrated on a different date than indicated or the possibility of a "Dose Calibrator" malfunction.
2. As a long time Nuclear Professional, I have consistently complied with all NRC regulations which were given to me by the Hospital's R.S.O.
If I continue in the Nuclear Medicine profession, as in the past, I will continue to comply with all required NRC regulations.
3. Steps that will be taken to prevent any violations will be that I keep myself abreast of all NRC regulations in regards to the Nuclear Medicine profession. This incident has brought to light that pertinent NRC regulations were not always provided to me by the R.S.O.
4. Full compliance of NRC requirements and regulations have always been achieved by myself. I feel if reviews were made of my previous status regarding compliance, findings would indicate exemplary achievements in my Record Keeping, Documentation and past NRC Inspections results.
