Gentlemen:

This refers to your amendment request received on September 20, 1982 regarding the change at your Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) and also, your request for authorization for RIA Kit dispensing for Material Licensing No. 37-07739-01. To continue our review at your request, we need the following additional information:

1. We need to know the exact title of Mr. Dean D. Rombach's position in your institution. It appears that he may be a Nuclear Medicine Technologist in your organization. The RSO is expected to supervise nuclear medicine technologists and physicians. Therefore, Mr. Rombach might be in the position of supervising (in terms of radiation safety) his immediate supervisors. You should explain the steps the management at this institution will take to ensure that there is no conflict between Mr. Rombach's duties as an RSO and Nuclear Medicine Technologist.
2. In regard to your request for authorization for RIA Kit dispensing to the laboratory, this activity may be done without a specific authorization so long as the hospital's possession of byproduct material does not exceed the limits specified in 10 CFR 31.11. This issue is explained in the enclosed letter dated December 1, 1980.

We will continue our review of your amendment request the information. Please reply in duplicate and refer to Control No. 12560.
