Gentlemen:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter dated December 13, 1960 notifying us of the sea disposal operation which you propose to conduct January 5, 1961, weather permitting.

During a telephone conversation with Mr. John Vaden on December 19, 1960, we were informed that Isotopes Specialties Company proposes to use a U. S. Coast Guard certificated, 300 ton barge operated by the Garvin Towboat Company. We would appreciate written confirmation of these arrangements for the sea transport of the waste. In addition we would like notification of the point of loading which you are to supply in accordance with your letter of December 13, 1960.

This will also acknowledge receipt of your letter dated December 12, 1960, requesting specific authorization to transport and dispose of sixty (60) drums of waste which have radiation levels at the surface which exceed 200 milliroentgens per hour. Pursuant to discussions with Mr. Fred Hour during an office visit and with Mr. John Vaden during a telephone conversation on December 19, 1960, we will wait for a more detailed statement of the situation and the proposed procedures before making a determination in the matter.
