

Dear Mr. Denton:

By letters from Mr. O. W. Dixon, Jr. to Mr. H. R. Denton dated August 30, 1985, September 18, 1985, and October 16, 1985, South Carolina Electric and Gas Company (SCE&G) requested a revision to the Virgil C. Summer Nuclear Station Technical Specifications to allow for specific alternatives to tube plugging in the steam generators. Based on the results of eddy-current testing performed during the present refueling outage, SCE&G has determined that the amendment is not necessary and requests that the Technical Specification revision be withdrawn.
