SUBJECT: Re - USNRC License 22-15764-01

Please be advised of the following changes in regard to our Materials License number 22-15764-01.

1. We plan to transfer ownership of our original Hewlett Packard Gas Chromatograph equipped with detector cell serial number H2370 to the Campbell Soup Company facility in Fremont, Nebraska. The Fremont Plant is licensed to receive this equipment under the State of Nebraska license number 05-04-01. Although we have not operated the instrument for some time, we have taken leak detection swabs in preparation for this transfer and results are satisfactory. Transportation will be accomplished by a company owned vehicle as soon as necessary arrangements can be made.
2. We have replaced our gas chromatograph with a new Hewlett Packard instrument which is equipped with two Model 3392A detectors. In keeping with our licensing requirements, these are sources of less than 15 millicuries each with serial numbers 240 8A 01137 and 240 8A 01138 respectively.
3. Mrs. T. Johnson is planning termination of employment and will no longer be handling licensed materials for us. A replacement for her will be named shortly and we would like to have that change included in the current amendment.

Please advise if you require any additional information and let me know what amendment or licensing fees will be required.
