Dear Mr. Johnson:

Although our present license number C-2734 as amended, permits us to obtain sufficient normal  $UF_6$  to fulfill our present commitment to Westinghouse for the Belgian Thermal Reactor, very little of the 4,000 pounds allowed us under this license will remain upon completion of the Westinghouse order. We request, therefore, that our license be amended to permit us to receive possession of and/or title to an additional 1,000 pounds of normal uranium hexafluoride. Amendment of our license at this time will prevent a last minute rush for such amendment should Westinghouse determine later that more  $UO_2$  is required or if other reactor builders should desire some of our material.

We request, also, that as in previous amendments, we be licensed to transfer and deliver possession of and/or title to source material to any person licensed by the Atomic Energy Commission, within the limits of his license.
