Dear Dr. Glenn:

Canberra Clinical Laboratory recently underwent inspection by NRC agents, Teresa Darden and Doris Foster. It was discovered at this time that our license No. 06-15099-02 has a possession limit of 5 millicuries for Iodine 125. At various times we have noted our supply to be over 4 millicuries. Therefore, the agents recommended that we apply to you for an increase in our current possession limits to 10 millicuries for Iodine 125. We would also like to ask for "special relief" to hold our stored mats for 5 half lives instead of 10.

Enclosed is a check for \$60.00, which is the amount I was told would be needed for these amendments to our license.

Please further advise me of any other necessary steps, so we may make these final amendments quickly and maintain our compliance.
