SUBJ: Amendment to NRC License No. 31-02892-03

1. We hereby request amendment to our license No. 31-02892-03 to permit us to have 50 mCi 31-Silicon instead of the 1 mCi, as previously authorized under Amendment No. 50.

2. This request is made for the following reason. In view of the relatively short half-life of 31-Silicon, 2.6 hours, the supplier, Brookhaven National Laboratory, has to ship a larger quantity, so that upon arrival at this facility, five or six hours later, sufficient material will be available to carry out the planned experiments. The 50 mCi 31-Si requested therefore actually represents the amount at the time of shipment.
