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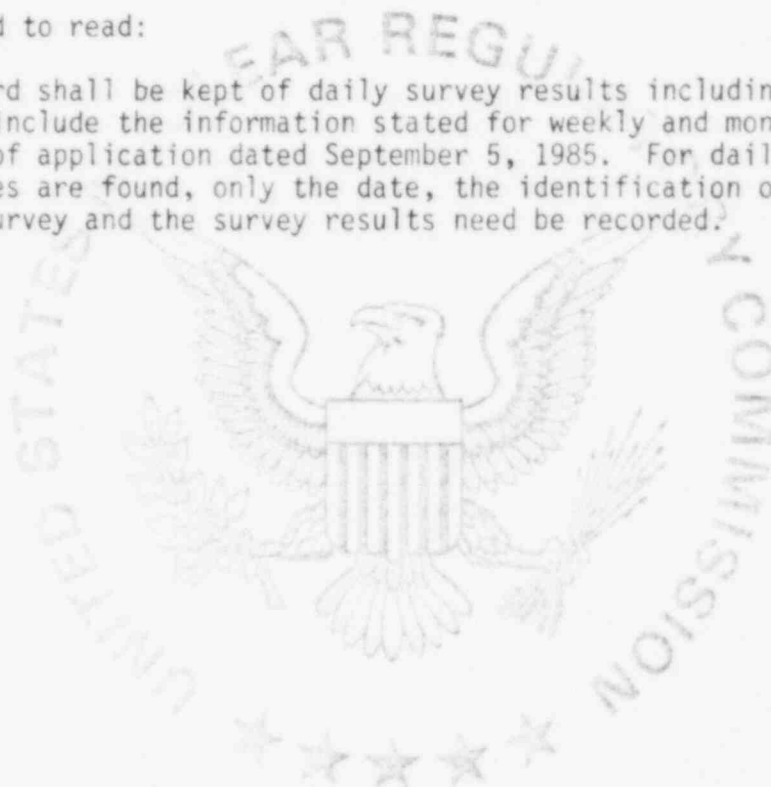

17. Except as specifically provided otherwise by this license, the licensee shall possess and use licensed material described in Items 6, 7, and 8 of this license in accordance with statements, representations, and procedures contained in application dated August 6, 1982, August 16, 1985 and September 5, 1985 and letter dated September 4, 1985 including ALARA Program. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulations shall govern the licensee's statements in applications or letters, unless the statements are more restrictive than the regulations.

Condition 18. is added to read:

18. A permanent record shall be kept of daily survey results including negative results. The record will include the information stated for weekly and monthly surveys in Item 17, page 2 of application dated September 5, 1985. For daily surveys where no abnormal exposures are found, only the date, the identification of the person performing the survey and the survey results need be recorded.
