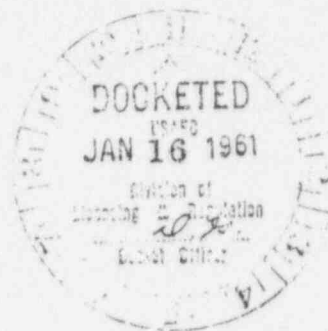

Gentlemen:

Transmitted herewith is Amendment No. 4 to License No. 4-580-6 issued pursuant to your application dated January 3, 1961.

You will notice that this licensing action amends Condition 3 to add personnel who may conduct or supervise the conduct of the waste disposal program. It further amends Condition 13 to add Section C. authorizing the sea disposal of liquid containing byproduct material in concentrations of not more than 1×10^{-4} microcuries per milliliter and not more than 1 pound of source material per drum in the specified type of container. This amendment does not relate in any way to your applications dated December 12 and December 22, 1960 requesting authorization to transport and dispose at sea eighty-five (85) drums of radioactive material having surface radiation levels in excess of 200 milliroentgens per hour. These applications are under consideration and you will be advised when further action is taken with respect to them.

Since the purchaser of the Isotopes Specialties Company, Division of Nuclear Corporation of America, Inc., does not hold a license authorizing the conduct of a commercial radioactive waste disposal program and since License No. 4-580-6 issued to Isotopes Specialties Company, Division of Nuclear Corporation of America, Inc., cannot be used by the new management, unless and until it may be transferred pursuant to 10 CFR 30.38, you are requested to immediately notify all customers of your waste disposal service, advising them of the termination of said service and your inability to accept further shipments of waste material until such time as the new management

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may obtain a license authorizing the conduct of a waste disposal service. This matter was discussed with Mr. Kenneth W. Newman during a telephone conversation January 10, 1961.
