AMENDMENT NO. 4

In accordance with application dated January 3, 1961, Condition 3 of License No. 4-580-6 is hereby amended to read as follows:

3. Byproduct, source and special nuclear material shall be received, possessed, packaged and disposed of by, or under the direct, personal supervision of, Carl Hinkinson, Alfred J. Moses, Kenneth W. Korman, Arthur Seibel, Robert E. Seiff or John D. Vaden.

License No. 4-580-6 is further amended under Condition 13 to add the following section:

13. C. Completely filled 30 gallon steel drums with screw type bung closure placed within 55 gallon open-head steel drums, with the annular and head space filled with concrete, may be used for the containment of radioactive liquid containing byproduct material in concentrations of not more than 1×10^{-4} microcuries per milliliter and not more than 1 pound of source material per drum.

This amendment is effective as of the date of issuance.
