Dear Mr. Mason:

Per our telephone conversation of January 9, 1961, this is to advise that:

1. Isotopes Specialties Company has been acquired by U.S. Nuclear Corp. from Nuclear Corporation of America as of January 1, 1961, pursuant to agreement which reads in part: "...NUCOR will and by this agreement hereby does sell, assign and transfer to U.S. (referring to U.S. Nuclear).....the name, good-will, capital equipment and product inventory.....".
2. Among the assets so acquired are waste disposal contracts including:
 - a. Hughes Aircraft covering low level waste, termination date December 31, 1961.
 - b. Douglas Aircraft covering low level waste, termination date January 31, 1962.
 - c. Isotopes Specialties Company also has been accepting and disposing of waste when required from several customers (not on a contractual basis) it being understood that Isotopes Specialties Company would pick up and dispose of waste when accumulated in customers premises. These customers are; (among others) - Robertshaw Fulton, Richfield Oil, Anaheim, Truesdail Laboratory.
3. As a result of the foregoing it is hereby requested that waste disposal license No. 4-580-6, issued to Isotopes Specialties Company, a Division of Nuclear Corporation of America, be transferred to Isotopes Specialties Company, Division of U.S. Nuclear Corporation with no change in address, since the agreement provides that U.S. Nuclear Corp. will be allowed to sublet a portion of the premises licensed at 170 W. Providencia.
4. Isotopes Specialties Company Isotope Committee will be altered as of January 16, 1961, to include the following personnel, resumes of whom are already in your possession:

5. Since time is of the essence speedy action is requested for the above.


