Gentlemen:

Reference is made to letters dated December 12, 1960 from Mr. A. J. Moses and December 12, 1960 from Mr. John D. Vaden regarding eighty-five (85) drums of radioactive waste which have radiation levels at the surface which exceed 200 milliroentgens per hour.

We understand from informal communications with Mr. Vaden that the referenced drums have been disposed of by transfer to the National Reactor Docket Station, Idaho Falls, Idaho for land burial. You are requested to verify this transfer and to verify that all waste byproduct, source and special nuclear material waste received under License No. 4-580-5 has been disposed of and is no longer in storage at 170 West Providencia, Burbank, California.
