QUANTITY**DESCRIPTION OF MATERIALS OR FACILITIES**

The licensee is authorized to export 200,000.0 kilograms of natural thorium/uranium (in concentrates ranging from 0.05 percent to 1.0 percent) contained as contaminants in rare earth compounds and mixtures.

This amendment 1) adds as Ultimate Consignees Argentina, Brazil, the People's Republic of China, Singapore, and Thailand; and 2) modifies the description of materials for export. The original license was issued on August 20, 1991.

The following conditions apply to exports under this license: 1) Prior consent by the Government of the United States of America is required for any use or retransfer of the contained uranium and thorium. 2) The material is for non-nuclear use only.

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Neither this license nor any right under this license shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the provisions of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended and the Energy Reorganization Act of 1974.
