Pursuant to 10CFR Part 30 and Part 33, Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) hereby applies for a Type A License of Broad Scope for By-Product Material for Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Unit No. 3. The application is presented in the format of Regulatory Guide 10.5, Revision 1 using NRC Form 313 with proposed Regulatory Guide 10.5, Revision 2 errata sheet guidance, provided by the NRC. As required, two copies of the entire completed application are enclosed.

We have been informed through telephone conversations with NRC Region I representatives that applications for new licenses generally receive priority attention and that issuance of the by-product material license should be within 30 to 45 days. NNECO remains available to meet with you to discuss any matter pertaining to review of the application and assist in facilitating the earliest possible issuance of the By-Product Material License.


