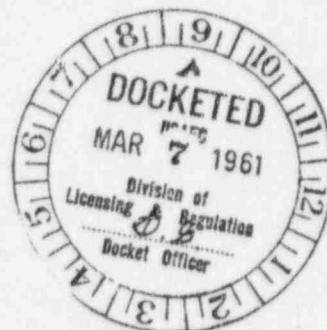

In order to proceed with our consideration of your application it will be necessary for you to submit the following:

1. Specific information regarding the facilities and equipment to be available to Isotopes Specialties Company Division of U. S. Nuclear Corporation at 170 West Providence, Burbank, California.
2. A statement that all representations, procedures and statements contained in the renewal application submitted July 23, 1960 by Isotopes Specialties Company, Division of Nuclear Corporation of America, Inc., will apply to the activities proposed by Isotopes Specialties Company, Division of U. S. Nuclear Corporation, or a detailed statement of those which will apply.
3. The information requested in our letter dated December 2, 1960.



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4. The minimum qualifications of training and experience in the use of radioactive material which will be recognized by the Isotopes Committee in designating the individuals under whose direct, personal supervision the waste disposal program will be conducted.
