By letters dated November 14, 1960, and January 11, 1961, licensee reported two incidents involving overexposures to employees as reported on film badges. The two cases were referred to the SAN Compliance Division for evaluation and appropriate action. Attached is a copy of a memorandum dated April 6, 1961, together with two interoffice memoranda setting forth results of investigations concerning the overexposures and recommending that the cases be considered as closed.

In light of the information set forth in the attached material, along with your memorandum dated March 22, 1961, which established that L&R would not take any action regarding the SAN inspection conducted November 3 and 4, 1960, no further inquiry into the above-referred to overexposures is planned by this office.
