In accordance with Manual Chapter 0707, and in response to memoranda from E. G. Outten dated 12/6/60 and from D. E. Warner dated 2/7/61, investigations of two reported overexposures were conducted. Attached are the reports of these investigations.

Since these exposures occurred, Isotope Specialties Company has been sold. It no longer exists as a company, but only as a "brand name" which is handled by U.S. Nuclear Corporation, Burbank, California, License 4-3241-1. Employees and most of the officers of the former Isotope Specialties Company are no longer available in the area.

Because the overexposures were only slightly in excess of the existing limits and because of the present status of Isotope Specialties Company, SAN Compliance Division believes that there is little to be gained by further investigation, and recommends no further action on these reported overexposures. We therefore consider the cases closed.
