Dear Mr. Price:

Thank you for your letter of May 18th, reference 40-2370 and the enclosures. The information contained in the latter will greatly help us to abide by regulations for handling contained radioactive material.

From the enclosure 10-CFR-40 amended, we understand that our original request for a license for handling thorium-containing source material is now not necessary since the contained thorium in the "source" material exists here as "unimportant quantities". We will want to receive from your office a verification of this exemption.

Regarding the matter of (1) safe handling, (2) records of handling, (3) monitoring records, and (4) waste disposal, we can report that these matters have been arranged for. Further details in the form of our procedure for these materials will be furnished at your request, if this seems necessary in light of the amendment (dated April 11, 1961) to 10-CFR-40.

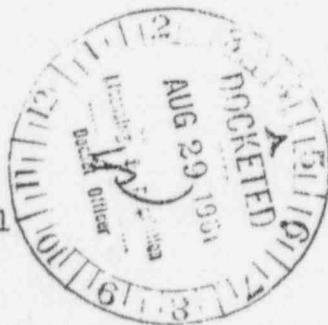
