

After a TRACER-flo user has completed the formal TRACER-flo maintenance course, they should be authorized to perform the following:

- 1) Leak test and repair or replace plumbing components of the complete transfer system.
- 2) Repair/replace valve kits of the complete transfer system.
- 3) Repair/replace electronic components.
- 4) Repair/replace valve pumps and compressor.

The following items they should not be authorized to perform unless approval has been received by the NRC:

- 1) Alter/modify any portion of the electronics or plumbing.
- 2) Remove/replace the activation or storage tank.
- 3) Deactivate, decontamination, or relocation of the activation console.
