Therefore, in view of your failure to reply to our letters, the application is hereby denied for failure to prosecute said application.

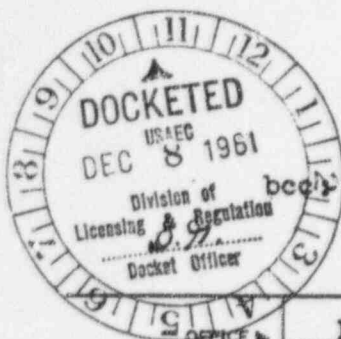
