IN SUPPORT OF ANTHONY/FOE'S REQUEST FOR STAY OF 8/1/85

On August 1, 1985 Intervenor Robert L. Anthony/Friends of the Earth (Anthony/FOE) filed a request for a stay of the Licensing Board's fourth partial initial decision, which authorizes the issuance of a full-power operating license for the Limerick facility. Pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 2.711 (a) Air and Water Pollution Patrol/Romano supports intervenor Robert L. Anthony (Friends of the Earth) request for stay for the factual reasons stated in the Anthony/FOE filing of August 1 and previous factual material submitted by Anthony/FOE.

Further AWPP/Romano filed a brief on July 20, 1985, materially backing the Anthony/FOE appeal of the Licensing Board's fourth partial initial decision, which authorizes the issuance of a full-power operating license for the Limerick facility and incorporates the July 26, 1985 AWPP/Romano appeal by reference herein.
