Subject: Inspection No. 30-05988/85-01

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by R. H. Ladun of this office on September 13, 1985 of activities authorized by NRC License No. 37-00314-06 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Ladun with Mr. J. Kennedy and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, measurements made by the inspector, and observations by the inspector.

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations were observed.

Based on the discussion at the conclusion of the inspection, we understand that your staff will take the following actions: 1) Prepare written procedures describing the calibration of the area radiation alarms; 2) Assure that the grade is placed on all radiographer tests; 3) Review all radiographer audit forms for completeness; and, 4) Emphasize in periodic training sessions, the need to record all radiography exposure device survey results which are required by 10 CFR 34.43(c). If our understandings are incorrect, please inform us in writing.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter will be placed in the Public Document Room.


