SUBJECT: GENERIC SECTION OF TVA'S EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS PLAN

On June 6, 1985, representatives of Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) met with NRC Region II personnel in Atlanta, Georgia. TVA requested this meeting as a followup to the meeting of May 7, 1985. The purpose of this meeting was to discuss and clarify all items identified during the NRC review of the draft generic plan. The attendance list is attached as an appendix to this Summary.

TVA representatives were provided comments regarding the generic plan review. These comments were derived by comparing and evaluating the draft generic plan to regulatory guidance in NUREG-0654. Licensee representatives and NRC personnel agreed that the draft plan satisfied many of the requirements outlined in NUREG-0654. However, several sections of the plan did not satisfy the cross reference to NUREG-0654 due to use of incorrect references and/or provision of insufficient information. TVA representatives also provided an update briefing and additional information on the draft plan to further clarify and correct some of the information submitted in the initial draft. Final discussion involved the implementation schedule for the generic plan. No further business was discussed by either organization.
