In reference to our application for a byproduct material license, we would like to assure you that the Brandhurst exit signs that we wish to stock will be sealed in cartons with labels, instructions and registration cards and will not be altered or removed by anyone at Debenham Electric Supply Company.

These signs will be physically checked for breakage and brightness before being sold to the end user.


No smoking will be allowed in the locked storage area or when evaluating or demonstrating the signs.

If the breakage of a sign should occur, the broken sign will be picked up with forceps and placed in a container with a tight fitting lid. The container will then be marked to indicate that it contains broken tritium sources.

The area and the forceps will be washed down thoroughly after the clean up operation. Rags and paper towels used in the clean up operation will be placed in the container with the broken sources. Disposal will be made by return of the sources to the manufacturer. We will then contact the manufacturer for proper shipping instructions.

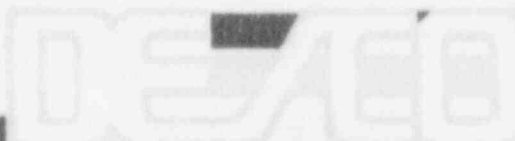
These procedures will be posted in the locked storage area and with the signs and our sales people will be educated on these procedures.
