Dear Mr. Low:

During the quarter ending October 4, 1970, accumulative exposures of 20.030, 20.380, and 20.180 millirems were reported for extremity film badges worn by three (3) individuals.

The data was received by us on October 6, 1970. The badges that placed them over the limit were worn during the period of September 21, 1970 to September 27, 1970.

We feel that the corrective measures outlined in our letter of September 25, 1970 are sufficient to prevent additional over-exposures. However, they were not in effect early enough to prevent these three individuals to exceed the limit.

All of the corrective measures are in effect and should result in appreciably reducing exposure for these operations.


