Gentlemen:

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Mr. James W. Patterson of this office on October 11, 1985, of activities authorized by NRC Byproduct Material License No. 14-18869-01 and to the discussion of our findings with you and Mr. Dan Strock, Chief Technologist at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, independent measurements, and interviews with personnel.


In addition to the above areas, the inspector examined actions described in your letter dated November 26, 1982, regarding apparent items of noncompliance found during our September 21, 1982 inspection. We have no further questions regarding these matters.

During this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in noncompliance with NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Appendix. A written response is required.
