NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Clarinda Municipal Hospital

License No. 14-18869-01

As a result of the inspection conducted on October 11, 1985, and in accordance with the General Policy and Procedures for NRC Enforcement Actions (10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C), the following violation was identified:

License Condition No. 19 requires that licensed material be possessed and used in accordance with statements, representations, and procedures contained in certain referenced applications and letters.

The referenced application (with attachments) received January 22, 1985 states that "Responsibilities, duties, and meeting frequency will be as described in Appendix B of the Guide for the Preparation of Applications for Medical Programs, Regulatory Guide 10.8, Revision 1, 1980, and as described in 10 CFR 35.11."


Contrary to the requirements of your application, the records of Isotope Committee meetings was incomplete. Specifically, there was no record available of the Committee having met during the period June 21, 1984 to June 7, 1985.

This is a Severity Level V violation (Supplement VI).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, you are required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of this Notice a written statement or explanation in reply, including for each item of noncompliance: (1) corrective action taken and the results achieved; (2) corrective action to be taken to avoid further noncompliance; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Consideration may be given to extending your response time for good cause shown.
