NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Jennie Edmundson Memorial Hospital

License No. 14-00950-02

As a result of the inspection conducted on October 10, 1985, and in accordance with the General Policy and Procedures for NRC Enforcement Actions, (10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C), the following violation was identified:

License Condition No. 16 requires that licensed material be possessed and used in accordance with the statements, representations, and procedures contained in certain referenced applications and letters.

The referenced application with attachments received April 6, 1978, states in Item 15, of your Lab Safety Procedures "Do not eat, drink, smoke or apply cosmetics in any area where radioactive material is stored or used."


Contrary to the above, on the day of this inspection, a bottle of soda pop was found in the Nuclear Medicine facility refrigerator intended for radioactive material only.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Supplement VI).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, you are required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of this Notice a written statement or explanation in reply, including for each item of noncompliance: (1) corrective action taken and the results achieved; (2) corrective action to be taken to avoid further noncompliance; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Consideration may be given to extending your response time for good cause shown.
