Subject: Inspection Report No. 030-20966/85-01

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Ms. Nancy Dennis of this office on June 13, 1985 of activities authorized by NRC License No. 08-23356-01, and to a subsequent telephone discussion between Ms. Dennis and Mr. Gerald Rapson of your staff on June 18, 1985 at 1151 Seven Locks Road in Rockville, Maryland.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations were observed.

From discussions of Ms. Dennis with Mr. Rapson of your staff on June 18, 1985, it is our understanding that you do not currently possess, and have not used, gauges containing radioactive materials in the District of Columbia or in other locations in the United States where the Nuclear Regulatory Commission maintains jurisdiction. We understand that your possession and use of such gauges has been limited to the State of Maryland. It is also our understanding that you plan to move into new facilities in the District of Columbia in the fall of 1985 and that you will store these gauges at these facilities. You are advised that, prior to your moving to the new facilities, that you must request amendment of your current license to reflect: 1) the location of your new facilities; 2) the use of any gauges which are not now authorized under Condition 9 of your license; and 3) to list Mr. Gerald Rapson as the Radiation Safety Officer. Please inform us in writing if any of our understandings are incorrect.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter will be placed in the Public Document Room.




