

Dear Sir:

Our dosimeter supplier recently reported a TLD reading of 3,250 mRem for the second quarter of 1975. The TLD covered the period 4/4/75 to 6/15/75. Film badges were worn for the weeks 6/16/75 and 6/23/75 for a two week total of 30 mRem. The individual's total exposure was 3,280 mRem for the quarter ending 6/29/75.

His pocket chamber dosimeter records show that most of the exposure was incurred while working in our radioactive waste packaging area from 4/4/75 to 5/25/75. During this period his pocket chamber data totaled 1,717 mRem, not including several non entries. Upon this information, we transferred him to a low exposure job for the duration of the quarter and advised him of the absolute necessity of keeping his pocket chamber record up to date.

The pocket chamber readings for the last 5 weeks of the quarter were 275 mRem for a total of 1,992 mRem.

We believed that we had taken appropriate action to prevent an exposure in excess of the limits specified in 10CFR 20.101 (b). However, the TLD data indicates that this was not the case, and this exposure is being accordingly reported in compliance with Paragraph 20.405.
