Subject: Inspection Report No. 030-13722/85-01

This refers to the routine, safety inspection conducted by Judith A. Joustra of this office on June 26, 1985, of activities authorized by NRC License No. 29-17962-01 and to the discussions of our findings held by Ms. Joustra with yourself at the conclusion of the inspection, and to a subsequent telephone discussion between yourself and Ms. Joustra on June 27, 1985.

The area examined during this inspection was limited to discussions of your plans for future activities authorized by this license. From these discussions, we understand that you have ceased all activities under this license, and that all materials have been disposed. Further, we understand that you plan to terminate this license. This may be accomplished by submitting a Form NRC 314 (enclosed) along with any documentation of closeout surveys for decontamination obtained prior to release of the area for unrestricted use. This information should be submitted to USNRC, Region I, 631 Park Avenue, King of Prussia, Pennsylvania 19406, with a request to terminate this license.

Based on the results of this inspection, it appears that one of your activities was not conducted in full compliance with NRC requirements, as set forth in the Notice of Violation, enclosed herewith as Appendix A. This violation has been categorized by severity level in accordance with the revised NRC Enforcement Policy (10 CFR 2, Appendix C) published in the Federal Register Notice (49 FR 8583) dated March 8, 1984. You are required to respond to this letter and in preparing your response, you should follow the instructions in Appendix A.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter and your reply will be placed in the Public Document Room.

The responses directed by this letter and the accompanying Notice are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, PL 96-511.
