NOTICE OF VIOLATION

As a result of the inspection conducted on June 26, 1985, and in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy (10 CFR 2, Appendix C), the following violation was identified:

10 CFR 30.36(b) requires that each licensee notify the Commission immediately in writing under 30.6 and request termination of the license when the licensee decides to terminate all activities involving materials authorized under the license. This notification and request for termination of the license must include a completed Form NRC 314 and a radiation survey report to confirm the absence of radioactive materials or to establish the levels of residual radioactive contamination.

Contrary to this requirement, as of June 26, 1985, activities under License No. 29-16912-01 had not been conducted since October 17, 1984. Specifically, laboratory areas had been released for unrestricted use and a license representative indicated no plans to resume any activities involving licensed materials. A Form NRC 314 had not been prepared and submitted to the NRC.

This is a Severity Level IV violation. (Supplement VI)

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, American Red Cross, Penn-Jersey Regional Red Cross Blood Program, is hereby required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of the letter which transmitted this Notice, a written statement or explanation in reply, including: (1) the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved; (2) corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Where good cause is shown, consideration will be given to extending this response time.

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
