Reference is made to L. R. Rogers' memorandum of July 14, 1959, concerning subject complaint.

At the request of OR Inspection Division, the Division of Public Health of the State of Missouri, analysed a water sample from [REDACTED] well. The results of the analysis indicated a total alpha activity of 4.5×10^{-9} μ c/ml and a total beta activity of 11.7×10^{-9} μ c/ml. Both of these values are well within the limits of Appendix B, Table 2, Column 2 of 10 CFR 20.
