2. Protection/Design features associated with internally generated missiles
3. Tornado missile barriers, diesel generator exhaust protection
4. Main steam valve building, AFW pump cubicles, Isolation Valve Cubicles
5. New and spent fuel storage facilities, spent fuel pool cooling system, safety injection and containment spray pump cubicles
6. Circulating and essential cooling water pump houses. ECW connection to AFW system (proposed Hose Connection)
7. HVAC systems
8. Electrical Auxiliary Building - control room, remote shutdown panel
9. Mechanical Auxiliary Building - component cooling water system, reactor make-up water systems, essential chilled water system
10. Turbine Building - condensate and feedwater system
11. Containment Building - Reactor Coolant System, RHR System, ECCS piping Accumulators sumps
12. Fuel Handling Building - Safety Injection Pump Cubicles, ECCS piping
13. MAB - RWST, ECCS piping, CVCS charging and letdown systems
