
Dear Mr. Thompson:

During the course of the NRC review on the Westinghouse topical reports on the steamline break methodology (WCAP-9226 and WCAP-9227), Westinghouse has provided responses to the staff's requests for additional information on several occasions (referenced letters). There are, however, a number of questions for which responses have not yet been formally supplied, although they have been discussed with members of your staff. Information was also supplied to Argonne National Laboratories in the summer of 1983 in lieu of formal responses to some of the requests for additional information in order to facilitate the staff's review of the topical reports.

Westinghouse has been preparing responses to the remainder of the questions during this year. We expect to have completed our work in the first quarter of 1986. Accordingly, Westinghouse will submit responses to the remaining questions by April 1, 1986.
