In the referenced letter, Zion Station requested the expiration of the Senior Operator License for William T'Niemi, License Number SOP-30347-3, Docket Number 55-30607. At that time, we indicated that we intended to maintain an option to reapply for a Senior Operator License for Mr. T'Niemi under the provisions of 10CFR55.47(a).

This letter is to inform you that Zion Station intends to exercise that option. Mr. T'Niemi will complete required reading packages for each cycle of the Licensed Operator Continuing Training Program which he missed after expiration of his license. In addition, he will complete all quizzes that were administered in the Licensed Operator Continuing Training Program during that period. Currently, Mr. T'Niemi is actively participating in the Licensed Operator Continuing Training Program. Mr. T'Niemi will complete a special program of instruction prior to re-application for a Senior Operator License. This program will consist of: manipulation of the controls while under the instruction and supervision of a Licensed Operator; plant re-familiarization and walk-throughs with the Licensed Operator Training Staff; participation in accelerated training on the simulator; and completion of selected Job Performance Measures.

Upon completion of this special program, Zion Station will submit an application for a Senior Operator License for Mr. T'Niemi, along with requests for waiver of the written and operating examinations and supporting documentation for those waiver requests.

Mr. William T'Niemi has been assigned to the position of Work Control Supervisor at Zion Station.
